



GETECCU is the Spanish IBD Organization and it was founded in 1990. It has markedly grown throughout the last years and nowadays it is composed of 810 members, namely Gastroenterologists, Surgeons, Pediatricians and Nurses focused on IBD in Spain. Its main aim is to promote research and education as well as influence on political and social actions on IBD in our country.

ANNUAL MEETING



GETECCU organizes an annual meeting with around 400 participants from all over the country which pretends to boost clinical and translational research among all members. Hot topics with special interest are also reviewed by national and international IBD experts.

YOUNG IBD GROUP



The Young IBD Group was founded to promote and support the initiation in IBD research for scientists under 40 years old. At this moment we have 160 members in this group. It organizes an annual meeting, with 48 participants last year.

SCIENTIFIC AND RESEARCH AREA

ENEIDA REGISTRY

ENEIDA accounts for "Estudio de determinantes genéticos y ambientales", a prospective national registry started in 2006 which holds clinical information and blood samples of IBD patients. Currently, 79 hospitals are prospectively including clinical data and there are more than 49,000 records.

ENEIDA represents the largest source of information for clinical and genetic studies, and generated the publication of 17 papers in high impact journals so far. At the end of 2017, 18 research projects were underway based on this important database, helping the scientific community to improve knowledge about the disease.

EDUCATION



Each year, GETECCU organises 3 courses specifically focused on those trainees in their last year of training. In 2017 this course has reached its 40th edition.

SOCIAL AREA

GETECCU maintains a close relationship with other national scientific societies like Rheumatology (SER) and the National Gastroenterology Society (AEG). We also share projects with patients societies (ACCU).



PUBLICATIONS

Since 1999 our Society has published 53 original papers, consensus documents and clinical practice guidelines in indexed medical journals.

STANDARDS OF CARE

VALIDATION AND QUALITY ASSURANCE OF IBD UNITS

GETECCU aims to unify quality criteria in the management of IBD patients based on 53 pre-established indicators which were developed from a Delphi consensus statement (J Crohns Colitis 2014;8:240-251). An external consultant verifies the accomplishment of the indicators and issues a certificate that recognizes their compliance. Currently, there are 13 certified IBD Units across the country.
